SPEAK OUT LOUD!

Speak out LOUD MEGAPHONE

- Paint
- Paint Brushes
- Scissors
- Plates for paints/ Cups for water
- Glue Gun/ Glue sticks
- Paper Towels
- Cover for Tables/ Tape
- Plastic Megaphones (see resource page for ordering)
- White tissue paper
- Scrapbooking paper
- Die cut flower punches
- Ribbon/ pom-pom trim
- Buttons/ rhinestones/ embellishments, etc...
- Scriptures to cut and paste on megaphone (see template)
- Legal size sheet of paper

Note: I bought the megaphones at Oriental Trading Co. They come in a pack of 12 for \$10.99. I got the tissue paper at the Dollar Tree and the embellishments are all materials from day one, two, and three! It's all LESS than 5 dollars per girl! So go ahead—SHOUT out God's WORD!

PreART Preparation

- Have the tissue cut out ahead of time. Simply trace your megaphone onto a sheet of newspaper to make a template (See video). Use this template to cut your tissue paper.
- Precut ribbon and fringe using the top and bottom circumference of the megaphone as guide. I labeled two clear bags. One for the top fringe and one for the bottom.
- Precut ribbon for "stems" of verse flowers and flowers from scrapbooking paper using flower "punches".

Helpful HINTS!

- The tissue can tear easily. Tell the girls not to get discouraged! (Hint...the STAIN of the day!) Glue Stick your ENTIRE megaphone FIRST then slowly add the tissue. It is simply serving as a base for the paint to adhere to.

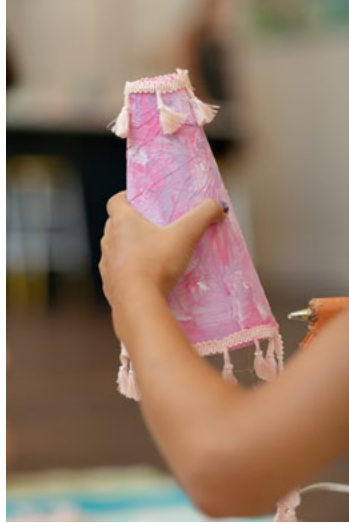


HOW TO MAKE • SPEAK OUT LOUD MEGAPHONE

HOW-TO 1: Cut out tissue to wrap around the megaphone. Use a glue STICK (not regular glue) and coat the megaphone with the glue stick. Carefully wrap the tissue around the plastic megaphone. It's okay if it tears, just rip off another strip and glue it into place. Trim any extra off and glue down any loose pieces. **2:** Mix two colors and paint over the tissue. Let Dry. **3:** Cut out the circle scriptures. **4:** Cut out trim to wrap the top and bottom of the cone. The top trim is about 6 inches and the bottom is about 14 inches. Hot glue in place. **5:** Glue on Scripture circles and cut out paper flowers and ribbon for stems. Use buttons and rhinestones for embellishing. Now, try your megaphone and SPEAK TRUTH against those discouragements OUT LOUD with the word of GOD!
