SIRIV: DEFINITION CORNER

PEER PRESSURE

Social pressure by members of one's peer group to take a certain action, adopt certain values, or otherwise conform in order to be accepted (Dictionary.com)

Today we will meet three very BRAVE men in the Bible. You may have heard about them before: Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. Their example of BRAVERY could be the best movie of the year! Picture this—as the fire gets hotter, so does King Nebuchadnezzar's temper. Yet, three men **stand firm in their faith** and stare into the face of death itself. Will they fall into peer pressure and submit to this mighty king's command to worship an **IDOL**? Or, will they hold on to the roots of their faith in God Almighty and risk their very lives? Grab some popcorn and take a look at Daniel 3:16-28. (Your leader will read Daniel 3:1-15 to set the stage.)

- 1. If you could choose a title for a movie about this story, what would it be?
- 2. Did Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego BOW DOWN to the peer pressure of worshiping the gold statue or STAND FIRM and TRUST in God? What do you think made their faith so confident? (vs. 17, 18)

"Do not make idols of any kind . . . You must never worship or bow down to them, for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God." Exodus 20:4-5

"You must not follow the crowd in doing wrong." Exodus 23:2 (NLT)

- 3. Read the verses above. What are some things you feel peer pressure to "bow" down to in our culture? Why does God not want us to follow the crowd in doing wrong?
- 4. Did God rescue them from having to go through this difficult circumstance? Why
- 5. Are you dealing with a peer pressure situation right now? Reading the definition for TRUST, how does God want you to trust in Him?

STAIN REMOVAL TIPS

- BRAVERY begins with **the choice to TRUST.** Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego chose to TRUST in God and BELIEVE He would save them—even if it meant walking into a FIERY FURNACE.
- Here are **THREE things** we can LEARN from their BRAVERY.
- 1. **BE READY FOR BATTLE.** We need to have STRONG convictions about our faith BEFORE we "face the furnace" of difficult circumstances. Shad, Mendy, and Bendy did not bow down to this idol but stood firm and TRUSTED that God would save them.
- 2. **HAVE STRONG FRIENDS** who will walk with you in life and share the same TRUST you have in God. True friends will not pressure you to do something wrong.
- 3. Sometimes God allows us to go through the "fire" of hard situations. But, **GOD IS TRUSTWORTHY!** He promises us that He is always with us (Isaiah 43:2-3), we will be joyful (Psalm 40:4), and our faith will only become **stronger** and more **confident** in who He is.
